**MONROVIA, 15 NOVEMBER 2020**, the Economic Community of West African States, ECOWAS Head of the Technical Data Support team to the Data Center of the National Elections Commission, and former Chairperson of the Ghanaian Electoral Commission today Sunday arrived in Liberia to help in the process to further cleanup the 2020 Voter Roll.

Speaking Sunday, 13 November 2020, upon her arrival at the Roberts International Airport in Margibi County, Madam Charlotte Osei said she was glad to be a part of the ECOWAS Technical Data Support Team assigned at the NEC, for 22 days to help the Commission to strengthen the integrity of the 2020 Voter Registration Roll.

The 2020 Final Registration Roll, FRR will be used in the 8 December 2020 Special Senatorial Elections, Constitutional Referendum and two Representatives By-Elections in Monterrado and Sinoe counties.
