The National Elections Commission (NEC), on Wednesday, 8 June 2022 and Tuesday, 7 June 2022 hosted two separate one-day meetings for members of a joint United Nations and Liberia National Bar Association (LNBA) on the compound of the commission in Sinkor.

The 9-member UN joint delegation was headed by the Chair of the Peacebuilding Commission (PBC), Liberia Configuration, Ambassador Anna Karin Enestron, also permanent Representative of Sweden to the UN. Others were, the UN Assistant Secretary General for Peacebuilding Support, Elizabeth Spehar, and the UN Resident Representative to Liberia, Neal Scott. The mission's primary objective was to discuss peacebuilding priorities with the Government and key shareholders, including the NEC.

On Tuesday, 7 June 2022, the Liberian Electoral Commission hosted a one-day meeting with a 3-member leadership delegation from the Liberia National Bar Association (LNBA), headed by its President, Cllr. Sylvester D. Rennie. Other members were, Cllr. Jamal C. Dehtho Jr., Vice President,

and Cllr. Bornor Varnah, Secretary. Cllr. Rennie said, the LNBA was concerned about how the two institutions can collaborate, through capacity building of NEC staff, relative to electoral disputes, moving toward the 2023 general elections in Liberia.
